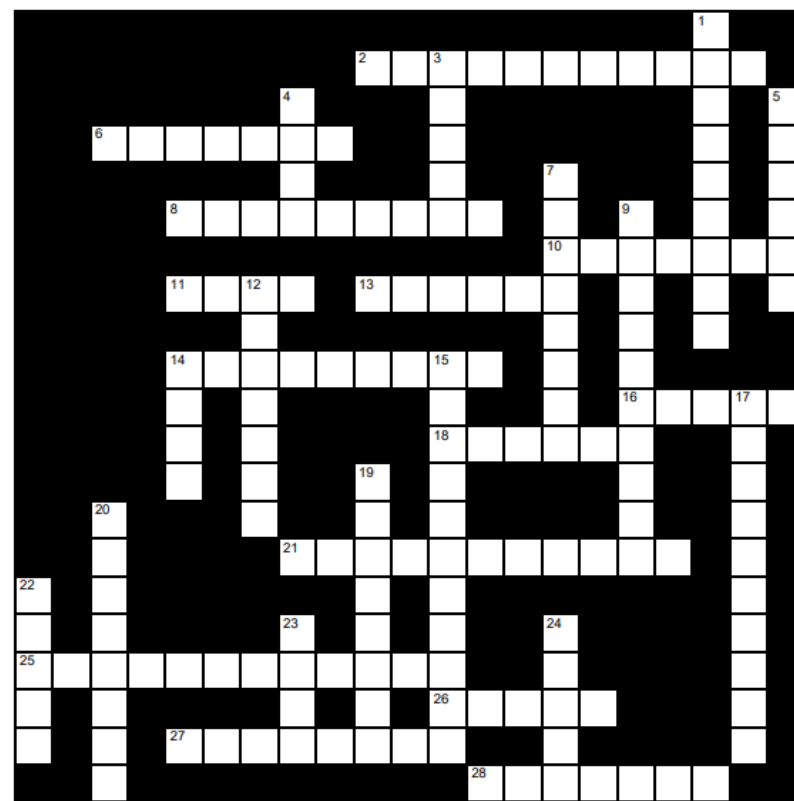

THIS WEEK: THE YELLOW BANQUET

MAKE THE BANQUET MEAL WITH US EVERY THURSDAY NIGHT THIS SUMMER

MAC & CHEESE

INGREDIENTS

1/2 lb. elbow macaroni pasta
6 slices of bacon
2 tbsp. all-purpose flour
1 1/2 cups milk
3/4 cup half n' half

1/2 tsp. cornstarch
1/2 tsp. Dijon mustard
1 1/2 tsp. chicken bouillon powder
1/2 tsp. onion powder
1/2 tsp. garlic powder

1/2 tsp. parsley flakes
2 cups shredded sharp cheddar
1/2 cup shredded parmesan
1/2 cup panko bread crumbs
1 tbsp. butter (melted)
1/2 tbsp. olive oil

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cook pasta according to package instructions. Don't overcook! Strain and rinse with cold water, set aside
2. Cook bacon in large skillet over medium heat until crispy. Remove some, but not all, grease from the pan.
3. Add 1 tablespoon of butter to pan and whisk in flour. Cook, stirring for 2 minutes. Reduce heat to low and gradually whisk in milk
4. Add cornstarch to the half n' half and whisk until smooth. Gradually add to skillet, then add mustard, bouillon, onion powder, garlic powder, parsley, salt, and pepper.
5. Cook sauce for few more minutes, until it begins to

- thicken. Remove from heat and stir in shredded cheddar
6. Crumble/chop bacon and add most to skillet, saving little for topping. Add cooked pasta and toss to evenly combine.
7. Lightly grease 8x8 baking dish.
8. Pour mixture into baking dish. Sprinkle parmesan cheese on top.
9. Add panko, melted butter and olive oil to skillet. Cook over medium-high heat, stirring constantly, until crumbs are golden brown
10. Evenly sprinkle them over mac and cheese. Add remaining bacon crumbles on top
11. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F and bake for 15-20 minutes or until bubbly. Serve warm and enjoy!

CORN ON THE COB

INGREDIENTS:

8 ears of corn
1 cup of milk

1/3 cup of sugar
1/4 cup of butter
1/4 cup whipping cream

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Remove corn husk and silk
2. Fill large pot halfway with water
3. Stir in milk, sugar, heavy whipping cream, and butter until ingredients melt/dissolve
4. Place corn into pot and reduce heat to low
5. Simmer corn for 7-8 minutes or until tender

LEMONADE

INGREDIENTS:

1 1/2 cups sugar

10 lemons
8 cups water

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Slice & remove seeds from 2 lemons, mash with sugar
2. Juice remaining lemons and combine other liquids
3. Strain liquid, chill, and enjoy!

PREPARING FOR BLOOMS-DAY

Over 60,000 new seed samples have been added to the Arctic “doomsday vault,” with total samples now topping 1 million. With concern over climate change and biodiversity loss, this collection will save food crops at risk of extinction and preserve plants that can feed a future population. These latest additions include contributions from the Cherokee Nation, the first Native American group to send crops to the vault.



THE GREAT GREEN WALL

Twenty one African nations have committed to building and maintaining the “Great Green Wall,” a chain of forests spreading across the entire continent at the southern edge of the Sahara Desert. This 4,750-mile initiative will prevent the spread of the Sahara, which has been worsened by climate change, and reduce the economic and environmental threat to some of the world’s poorest and least developed nations.
